Step 1

ASSESS

Educators gain **instant access to interactive** summary and detailed **reports**.

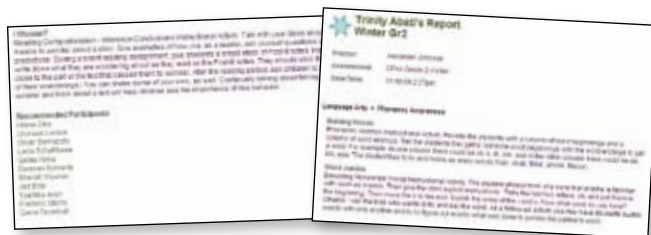
