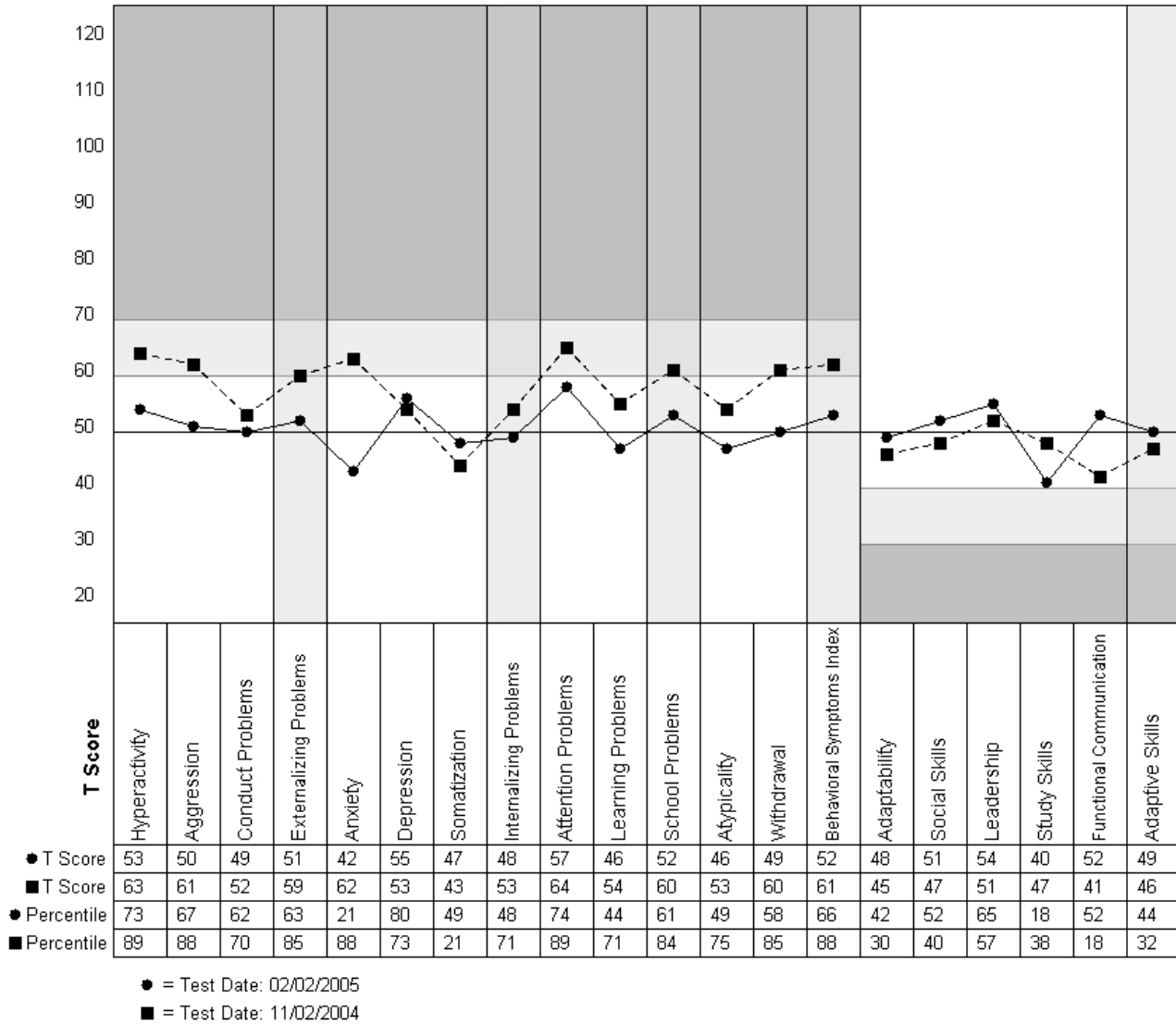

## Scale Summary

This report is based on MRS MATH's rating of TIMMY's behavior using the BASC-2 Teacher Rating Scales form. The narrative and scale classifications in this report are based on T scores obtained using norms. Scale scores in the Clinically Significant range suggest a high level of maladjustment. Scores in the At-Risk range may identify a significant problem that may not be severe enough to require formal treatment or may identify the potential of developing a problem that needs careful monitoring.

### Externalizing Problems

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The Externalizing Problems composite-scale T score is 51, with a 90 percent confidence-interval range of 48-54 and a percentile rank of 63. TIMMY's T score on Hyperactivity is 53 and has a percentile rank of 73. His T score on Aggression is 50 and has a percentile rank of 67. Also, his T score on Conduct Problems is 49 and has a percentile rank of 62.

### Internalizing Problems

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The Internalizing Problems composite-scale T score is 48, with a 90 percent confidence-interval range of 43-53 and a percentile rank of 48. TIMMY's T score on Anxiety is 42 and has a percentile rank of 21. His T score on Depression is 55 and has a percentile rank of 80. Also, his T score on Somatization is 47 and has a percentile rank of 49.

### School Problems

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The School Problems composite-scale T score is 52, with a 90 percent confidence-interval range of 48-56 and a percentile rank of 61. TIMMY's T score on Attention Problems is 57 and has a percentile rank of 74. Also, his T score on Learning Problems is 46 and has a percentile rank of 44.

### Behavioral Symptoms Index

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The Behavioral Symptoms Index composite-scale T score is 52, with a 90 percent confidence-interval range of 49-55 and a percentile rank of 66. TIMMY's T score on Hyperactivity is 53 and has a percentile rank of 73. His T score on Aggression is 50 and has a percentile rank of 67. His T score on Depression is 55 and has a percentile rank of 80. TIMMY's T score on Attention Problems is 57 and has a percentile rank of 74. His T score on Atypicality is 46 and has a percentile rank of 49. Also, his T score on Withdrawal is 49 and has a percentile rank of 58.

### Adaptive Skills

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The Adaptive Skills composite-scale T score is 49, with a 90 percent confidence-interval range of 46-52 and a percentile rank of 44. TIMMY's T score on Adaptability is 48 and has a percentile rank of 42. His T score on Social Skills is 51 and has a percentile rank of 52. His T score on Leadership is 54 and has a percentile rank of 65. His T score on Study Skills is 40 and has a percentile rank of 18. This T score falls in the At-Risk classification range. Finally, TIMMY's T score on Functional Communication is 52 and has a percentile rank of 52.
