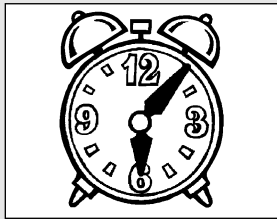

**Toy piano**

Elevate tongue tip to the alveolar ridge. Press upward slightly as air is released and the voice is used.

- Tap keys of a toy piano as you say or sing "la la la."
- Activate a musical toy by tapping it and saying "la la la."
- Have doll or puppet pretend to sing "la la la."
- Substitute "la la" for the words of a favorite song.
- Sing "The La Song."

**t**  
**Clock**

Elevate tongue tip to the alveolar ridge. Build up air pressure behind the tongue. Release air suddenly with no voice.

- Tap a clock repeatedly. Say "Let's be a clock" and say "t t t" (for ticking).
- Hold clock to your ear as you say "t t t, I hear it! You be the clock!"
- Extend your index finger downward and move back and forth as if it were a pendulum as you model "t t t."
- Use play dough and poke holes in it while saying "t t t."
