SCREENING RESULTS

Developmental Indicators for the Assessment of Learning-Third Edition (DIAL-3) is an individually administered developmental screening test designed to identify young children in need of further diagnostic assessment.

On June 14, 2006, Kayla Ottman was screened with the DIAL-3. Kayla was 4 years, 1 month at the time of screening. The Parent Questionnaire was completed by: Barbara. Kayla was screened using the English version.

In the Motor area, Kayla had a scaled score of 13 and a percentile rank of 79. According to the 7% (1.5 SD) cutoff, her score is in the OK range.

The Concepts area scaled score was 12, which corresponds to a percentile rank of 39. Using a 7% (1.5 SD) cutoff, her score is in the OK range.

Kayla had a scaled score of 5 and a percentile rank of 3 in the Language area. Her score is in the Potential Delay range according to the 7% (1.5 SD) cutoff.

Kayla's DIAL-3 Total score was in the OK range, using the 7% (1.5 SD) cutoff. She had a scaled score total of 30, which yields a percentile rank of 29.

Based on the responses on the Parent Questionnaire, Kayla had a Self-Help Development raw score of 15 and a percentile rank of 2. According to the 7% (1.5 SD) cutoff, her score is in the Potential Delay range.

Also based on the responses on the Parent Questionnaire, Kayla had a Social Development raw score of 23 and a percentile rank of 14. According to the 7% (1.5 SD) cutoff, her score falls in the OK range.

Kayla exhibited age-appropriate development in Motor, Concepts and Social. She scored in the Potential Delay range on Language and Self-Help.
