The new WAIS-5 subtests

Set Relations: New Fluid Reasoning subtest that measures deductive reasoning and logical thinking. **Running Digits:** New Working Memory subtest that measures auditory working memory that requires both flexibility in information processing and a progressive shift of attention.

Naming Speed Quantity: New Processing Speed subtest that measures numerical processing fluency and the ability to recognize and label quantities efficiently. **Spatial Addition:** A measure of Visual Working Memory that measures visual-spatial working memory and requires storage, manipulation, and ability to ignore competing stimuli (also included on WMS®–IV and WMS-5).

Symbol Span: A measure of Visual Working Memory that measures the capacity to hold a mental image of a design in mind and the relative spatial position on the page (also included on WMS–IV and WMS-5)
