Early identification of those with autism spectrum disorder has shown to be the most effective in empowering children to reach their full potential. Our assessments support the creation of targeted support plans, and interventions can be implemented to enhance communication, improve peer interactions, and provide strategies for managing classroom and social behaviors.

BASC-3 use in ASD

When conducting evaluations for ASD, it is important to remember that behaviors such as difficulty with social interactions and repetitive behaviors may overlap with other disorders like ADHD or anxiety. The BASC-3 TRS and PRS offer an Autism Probability Index (API) and Developmental Social Disorders (DSD) scale. Independent researchers have found that both scales perform well at differentiating Autism Spectrum Disorders from other developmental disorders. Consider using these powerful scales to help clarify whether a child has an Autism Spectrum Disorder. For those using the TRS and PRS for assessing a child, these scales are already available to you to help clarify the diagnostic picture.

What makes the BASC-3 useful?

- Current behavior in multiple settings and multiple raters
- Assessed via multiple methods
- Broadband measure and looks at common symptoms
- Rule out mimics and rule in comorbidities
- Evaluation of feelings, emotions, and self-perceptions (SRP) and Parent-child relationships (PRQ).

PRQ

Provides understanding of the child-parent interaction

Has seven scales to measure:

- Attachment
- Communication
- Discipline Practices
- Involvement
- Parenting Confidence
- Satisfaction With School
- Relational Frustration

Autism Probability Index

Children who present with elevated scores on this index likely exhibit a variety of behaviors that are considered by others to be unusual and experience problems with developing and maintaining social relationships, social communication, and reciprocal interaction.
