The **Early Screening Inventory™**, **Third Edition (ESI-3)** is an individually administered screening instrument that helps identify children who may need special education services. It's an easy-to-use, individually administered development screener used to identify possible delays across the domains of English and Spanish-speaking students. Determine if children are ready for the next level with a clear picture of visual motor/adaptive; gross motor; language; cognition; and social-emotional skills. The ESI-3 can be used in school and early childhood settings and relies primarily on direct observation of the student.



Developmental Indicators for the Assessment of Learning[™], Fourth Edition (DIAL-4) is a global screener for assessing large groups of children quickly and efficiently. It provides standard deviation and percentile cutoff points by chronological age at two-month intervals for total and area scores—Motor, Concepts, Language, Self-Help, and Social Development. Percentile ranks and standard scores are also provided.
