DRA3 is one-to-one assessment of oral reading and reading comprehension for grades K-8.

Through extensive field research and a large selection of engaging fiction and nonfiction benchmark texts at every level, DRA3 uses efficient scoring rubrics within teacher observation forms as an assessment that offers educators the tools they need to observe and document student reading level and helps inform instructional practice.

The Shaywitz DyslexiaScreen is a brief, valid, and reliable dyslexia screener for grades K-3.

This teacher-friendly observational rating scale offers efficient digital administration, scoring, and individual and group reporting for identification of students who may be at risk for dyslexia.
