How to Download and Access WISC-6 Standardization Audio Files

1. Go to the Examiner Hub

Navigate to the <u>Examiner Hub</u> and make sure you are on the WISC-6 Standardization project page.

2. Locate the Audio Files

- Scroll down to "Project Tutorials and Important Documents."
- Open this section and find the "WISC-6 Standardization audio files."

3. Open the PDF

• Click on the link to launch the PDF containing the audio files.

4. Download the PDF to Your Computer

• Important: You must download the PDF to your desktop or laptop. Chromebooks, tablets, and phones will not work for this step.

5. Open the PDF in Adobe Acrobat

- Open the downloaded PDF using Adobe Acrobat (the free Reader version is fine—no need to purchase anything).
- Important: You MUST open this document within Adobe Acrobat to download the files- you cannot open it in your internet browser.

6. Access the Audio Files

- In Adobe Acrobat, click the big blue text labeled "Access Audio Files."
- A bar will appear on the right with the audio files listed.

7. Save the Audio Files

- To save all files at once: Select the first file, scroll to the bottom, hold Shift, and select the last file to highlight all.
- Right-click and choose "Save Attachment."
- Choose a folder on your computer to save the files.

8. Play the Audio Files

Open the saved audio files with your preferred audio player (e.g., Windows Media Player).

9. Optional: Transfer Files to Other Devices

• If you want to use the audio files on your phone or another device, email them to yourself or upload them to your cloud storage for easy access.
