The information collected will help improve the BASC-4 rating scales, benefiting countless students for years to come! The teacher rating form is for research purposes only and will not impact your child or their schooling in any way.

How You Can Help:

- **Brainstorm!** Think through which teacher would be the best fit to fill out the form. This could be your child's primary classroom teacher, but it could also be someone else at school who spends time with your child, like a specials teacher, reading specialist, or classroom aide.
- Introduce Us! A simple introduction from YOU can open the door for teacher participation. Sharing some general information and letting them know a rating form will arrive in their email soon will help. Be sure to let them know they can complete the form at a time that works best for them!
- Your Examiner Has the Answers! Let the teacher know that the person you are
 working with, an Examiner, is available to answer any questions they may have
 about this project (i.e., type of questions, compensation, etc.).
