

# Computer Specifications and Software Components

To use the MAT CBT software, computers must meet the following specifications.

## Minimum System Requirements

- Windows 98/ME/XP/ NT 4.0/2000
- Microsoft Internet Explorer 6.0
- Pentium II 400 MHz processor
- 128 MB RAM
- Display capable of 800x600 resolution with 256 colors
- 280 MB free hard disk space required (40MB additional required for installation)
- Mouse or compatible pointing device
- Internet connection

## Recommended System Requirements

- Windows 7 and later including Windows 10 and 64-bit operating systems
- Microsoft Internet Explorer 9.0 or higher
- 1 GHz processor
- 1 GB RAM (more memory improves performance)
- Display capable of 1024x768 resolution with 256 colors
- 320 MB free hard disk space
- Mouse or compatible pointing device
- Internet connection

**NOTE:** It is strongly recommended that your CTC use an uninterruptible power supply, which will allow examinees to continue taking the MAT in the event of a power outage.

**NOTE:** If your CTC uses a Desktop Management Software, such as Deep Freeze™, which restores an image after you restart the computer, you will need to contact your internal Technical Support for help in allowing write access to the MAT folder and its contents.
