

ITEM-LEVEL INFORMATION

Unscorable Responses

The test taker produced scorable responses to all the MPQ items.

User-Designated Item-Level Information

The following item-level information is based on the report user's selection of scales and cutoffs. When a selected T score cutoff of 55 or above for a scale is met, the items answered by the test taker in the keyed direction are listed, because those are the responses that contributed to the above-average score. When a selected cutoff of 45 or 40 is met for a Higher-Order or Primary Trait scale (i.e., the T score is at or below the cutoff), the items answered in the nonkeyed direction are shown, because those responses contributed to the below-average score. When a scale is selected for item-level information with no cutoff, items answered in both the keyed direction and the nonkeyed direction are listed. The percentage of the MPQ normative sample (NS) and of the University Student Comparison Group (CG) that answered each item in the direction indicated are provided in parentheses following the item content.
