Why am I being asked to participate?

The purpose of this study is to evaluate the new test, not to reach any conclusions about participants. Based on the results of our research, we will create the final version of the test. Your participation helps us to "test" the test.

What will I be asked to do?

You will be asked to complete tasks related to vocabulary, reading, memory, and problem solving. The testing will last about **30-40 minutes** using a **computer video call**. You will need a computer with a camera and internet access to participate. Testing is scheduled at your convenience.

Will I receive compensation for participation?

Yes, you will receive \$20 in the form of an Amazon.com gift code for participating in the study.

Will I get the test results?

No. We use the information we obtain to select items for the final version of the test.

Is my participation confidential?

Your name and contact information are only collected to schedule the test and process the payment. Your name will not be saved or associated with your scores. We will not share your information with any outside institution.

Does this have anything to do with immigration enforcement?

No. We do not report any personally identifiable information to any government agency.
