

## Student Scoreboard Report


WriteToLearn offers a variety of reports to track student progress and guide instruction. Reports are downloadable and printable.

### Reports for Students

#### Student Scoreboard:

Students receive immediate feedback on their essays. The student scoreboard shows students an overview of their current scores, the number of submissions remaining, progress from last revision, and how close they are to passing.

Students get personalized feedback with the Student Scoreboard report, and they can refer to these scores as they work to improve their next draft.
