He is co-editor of the second editions of *Forensic Uses of Clinical Assessment Instruments* (2013) and *Personality Assessment* (2014), and co-author of the *MMPI-A Casebook* (PAR, 1994).

Dr. Archer served on the advisory committee to the University of Minnesota Press for the development of the MMPI-A, is a co-author of the MMPI-A manual, and co-author of the MMPI-A-RF (Restructured Form). He is an Executive Board member and Diplomate of the American Board of Assessment Psychology, and President of the Society for Personality Assessment.
